At OrthoIndy, physicians provide a complete range of orthopaedic care. Most practices specialize in one or two areas of orthopaedics, while OrthoIndy provides complete bone, joint, spine and muscle care. With more than 75 orthopaedic specialists serving residents from 14 convenient locations, OrthoIndy is the largest private, full-service orthopaedic practice in the Midwest, and one of the largest in the country.

OrthoIndy physicians provide care to the Indiana Pacers, Indiana Fever, Indiana Ice, Indianapolis Indians, IndyRacing League and Naptown Roller Girls, as well as local colleges and high schools.

OrthoIndy physicians are also actively involved in various aspects of orthopaedic research and quality outcomes. The physicians also remain on the leading edge of research and development of new procedures and techniques.

In March of 2005, OrthoIndy opened its very own orthopaedic hospital to better serve its patients. Owned by the OrthoIndy physicians, Indiana Orthopaedic Hospital (IOH) is central Indiana's first and only specialty hospital with a direct focus on orthopaedic care and the most technologically advanced facility available for orthopaedic care in the Midwest. As a 5-Star rated facility, IOH focuses on musculoskeletal care and complex surgical procedures including total joints (hip and knee) and spinal operations.

Spanning over 130,000 square feet, IOH was built when OrthoIndy physicians saw an increasing need to provide specialized orthopaedic care in a patient-focused environment. Designed by orthopaedic physicians and health-care architects, IOH is light, airy and modern, offering patients, as well as their family members, a comfortable and home-like environment.

Services provided by IOH will enable patients to return to a more active lifestyle, quicker and in most cases, with less pain. Because of advancements in medical technology, many of the surgeries performed at IOH can be completed on an outpatient basis, consisting of patient stays lasting 23 hours or less. For patients who are undergoing more invasive procedures, IOH provides inpatient care with round-the-clock patient-focused services and staff.

To accommodate residents on the west and south-side of Indianapolis, IOH built additional facilities: IOH West in Brownsburg and IOH South in Greenwood.

IOH has received numerous national awards, including 5-Star ratings from HealthGrades and the 2009 and 2010 Press Ganey Summit Award for sustaining the highest level of customer satisfaction for three or more consecutive years. In 2011, IOH was ranked #1 in the Nation for Patient Safety for Major Orthopaedic Surgery by CareChex.
